

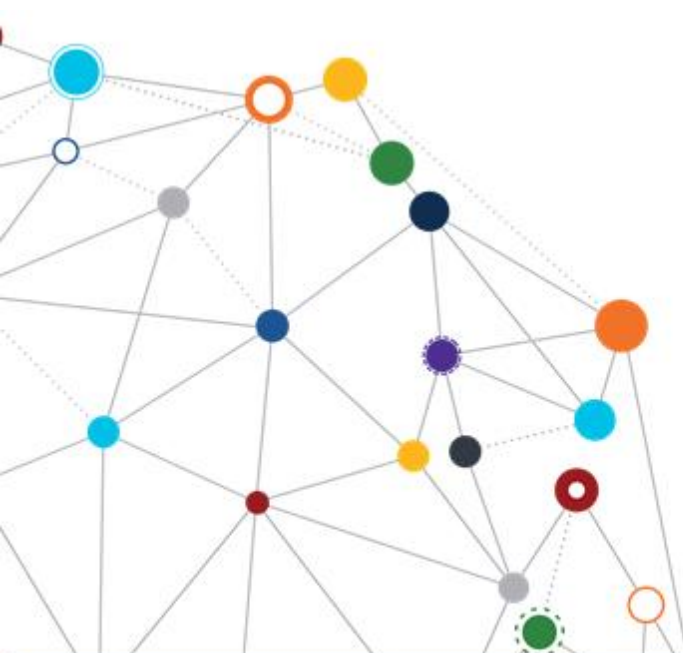

- The same person may be able to combine TtT and SME trainer role/status.
