INTERBA AT A GLANCE!

INTERBA is an Erasmus+ Capacity Building in Higher Education project, led by the University of Tirana, Albania. The consortium has 10 partners out of which 6 are HEIs from the Western Balkans, and 4 partners HEIs from Program countries namely: Germany, Italy and the UK. The project is envisaged to last for 3 years.

INTERBA project's general aim is to strengthen international, intercultural & global dimension via Internalization at Home (IaH) implementation at partner HEIs to enhance the quality of education and make a meaningful contribution to the society.

Project specific objectives:

- To formulate a coherent and detailed laH concept that could be mainstreamed into the partner HEIs Roadmaps following on from their specific exigencies;
- To level up the scope and viability of IaH activities implemented in partner HEIs;
- To train expert pool capable of developing and integrating laH into HEI environment;
- To launch an online platform as a tool for laH implementation;
- To establish/modernise structure/entities responsible for laH at HEIs.

Project Outcomes:

- 5 staff from each Partner Higher Education Institution trained;
- 20-30 staff re-trained in each Partner Higher Education Institution;
- 240-360 trainees and visiting academic staff;
- 500 trainees overall in the region will be part of the network of experts; etc.



WHAT DO WE DO?

WORK PACKAGE 1:

Gap analysis and the existing knowledge capital analysis (Lead partner – Universum College)

WP 1 aims at creating the project's foundation by conducting a needs analysis at institutional, national and regional levels. Needs assessment will is focused on identifying those areas that will have major impact from the redeployment of the knowledge capital of existing projects. This WP will conclude with the prioritisation of the areas that will receive the project's support in the form of reshaping existing knowledge, providing new knowledge and exploring the links to other current projects that could provide knowledge.



WORK PACKAGE 2:

Suggestion of a coordination model for use of existing resources based on a knowledge capital repository (Lead partner - University of Cagliari)

WP 2 aims at creating a coordination model that will help to exploit the knowledge capital of all partner institution in an effective way. The employed methods by the WP leader will help in identifying knowledge capital cases and associated uses that can bring clear benefits to other institutions of the consortium. Project partners too will ensure that a network of experts is created to support the project implementation and the sustainability of the results.

WORK PACKAGE 3:

Development of training packages to support the IoH capacity building at partners HEIs (Lead partner - Middlesex University)

WP 3 aims at creating a series of short courses helping staff at partner HEIs to become members of the network of experts. The training package focus on skills necessary for knowledge sharing, training, and capacity building. This WP assists too in training experts to prepare and deliver short training programs for knowledge transfer and the multiplication of the achieved results. An important part of the WP is the creation of guidelines for putting together Request for Knowledge (RfK) documents submitted to the network of experts asking for knowledge transfer short courses.

WORK PACKAGE 4: Organisation of training and re-training (Lead partner - Middlesex University)

WP 4 aims at training the key concerned staff from all partner HEIs in EU through 'Train the Trainers' (TtT) workshops and conducting training pilots in each WB country with the participation of all under the monitoring of the EU partners. The WP also involves monitoring the retraining sessions with the participation of peripheral institutions.
